WOMEN'S CITY TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The following rules, plus USBC rules, will govern all participants in this tournament.
2. All entrants must be adult 2011-2012 members of the Panama City Association and USBC.
3. This tournament will consist of a four-woman team event, doubles event, singles event, and optional all events, scratch and handicap. Bowlers may enter both scratch and handicap all events. Bowlers must be entered in the singles event to bowl in the doubles event. Singles will be bowled immediately following doubles. Multiple participation is allowed only in team event.
4. Not more than three players on one team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. **The first team event bowled counts for All Events.**
5. Entrants will use their highest 2010-2011 USBC sanctioned winter league yearbook averages based on 21 games or more. If no yearbook average, entrants will use their league average for 21 games as of 12/31/11. If no 12/31/11 average, entrant may use her summer 2011 average. Otherwise, entrants will use their highest current league average, based on 12 games or more as of the closing date of Jan 4, 2012. Entrants without established yearbook averages are responsible for providing confirmation of their average. All others bowl scratch. **The ten-pin rule will be enforced (Rule # 319A).** In addition, the tournament managers reserve the right to re-rate a bowler at any time.
6. Substitutes are permitted upon notification. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the entry fee to the original bowler and she is not expected to give the original entrant any prize money or trophy she may win. Pacers are not permitted. If a bowler is late for the doubles event, the bowler present will bowl singles first, if no substitute is available. There will be three sets of doubles and singles to a pair of lanes, when possible. Handicap will be based on 90% of 200.
7. Team lanes will be drawn by the team captain. Schedules will not be changed after the entries have been received and dates assigned by the tournament secretary. Changes in team or doubles lineup will be not be permitted after entry has been processed.
8. The entry closing date is midnight, Jan 4, 2012. No entries will be accepted without applicable entry fees. All entries postmarked the first post office business date after the entry closing date will be accepted. Entry fee will not be refunded after any entry has been received and dates assigned by the tournament secretary. There will be a \$10.00 charge on all returned checks plus any applicable bank fees.
9. Prize fund will be returned 100% (90% handicap and 10% scratch). Prize ratio will be at least 1-6 for handicap team, doubles, and singles events; 1-6 for scratch team, doubles, and singles events; and 1-6 for scratch and handicap All Events. In the case of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared with the first and second place prize money equally divided and duplicate trophies and emblems awarded. If ties occur in other positions, prize money will be combined and divided equally.
10. Any protest affecting the eligibility or general tournament rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director before tournament prize money has been paid. Errors must be reported within 24 hours to the tournament director. No profanity or obscene gestures will be permitted. Appropriate attire is required, no tank or strapless tops or spaghetti straps allowed; collared shirts preferred. Bowlers must observe House rules at each Tournament site.
11. The PC-USBC Board of Directors will decide on any questions or protests arising from this tournament. Their decision will be final subject to an appeal to USBC.
